A. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report provides a side-by-side comparison of the preliminary Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) enrolment figures for September 12, 2018 with the Board approved projected enrolment for October 31, 2018. Historically, staff have been able to annually project enrolment for the following school year to a high degree of accuracy (+/- 0.5%).

The cumulative staff time required to prepare this report was 2 hours.

B. PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is to provide the Board of Trustees with preliminary enrolment figures for the elementary and secondary panels based on actual Trillium enrolment data. Please refer to enrolment tables below.

C. ANALYSIS

1. Elementary Panel Enrolment (FTE)
