ELIGIBLE VOTERS - THE CSPC CHAIRS OF THE ELECTION WARD

- The CSPC chair of each school in the designated CPIC Ward or Ward cluster of secondary schools shall be the **only eligible voter** for the position of elementary or secondary CPIC Ward parent representative
- Each attending CSPC chair will be entitled to one (1) vote
- If a CSPC has co-chairs only one (1) person will be entitled to cast a vote
- There shall be no other substitute voters

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES OF CPIC MEMBERS

- Observe and uphold CPIC's Bylaws, Policies and Code of Ethical Conduct
- Attend all CPIC meetings
- Participate actively in CPIC meetings
- Conduct themselves at CPIC meetings in a professional and cordial manner in the context of Christian and Catholic gospel values
- Act as a link between CPIC and their respective Ward or Ward cluster of schools in support of programs to improve student achievement and wellbeing
- Make every effort to be representative of Toronto CPIC, as possible
- Participate in information and training programs
- Agree to be photographed or recorded while executing duties
- Shall serve on a minimum of one (1) standing subcommittee established by CPIC
- Shall hold at least one (1) in person, or electronic, meeting of their Ward or Ward cluster of schools per operating year
