I am advocating that the St. Margaret/Baycrest project be on top of the capital priorities. I have followed the progress of this project. So much work has been put into it already. We are not on the starting phase; we have gone through several stages and designs are already made. This project has funds and what is just needed now is an additional funding.

As of now, St. Margaret is divided into two campuses because we have our population is too big for the size of the campus. I understand that another nearby school, OLA has a population count that is also too big for its campus.

The completion of the renovation of the St. Margaret campus and the building of a new Catholic school on the Baycrest elementary school site will not on only put all of St. Margaret's students in one campus, but also will solve the over-population situation of two schools.
