

A. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The report provides recommended updates to the Acceptable Use of Technology policy (formerly A.29) to comply with the expectations in the Ministry of Educations updated Policy/Program Memorandum 128: The Provincial Code of Conduct and School Board Codes of Conduct (PPM 128).

The cumulative staff time required to prepare this report was 5 hours.

B. PURPOSE

1. To update the Acceptable Use of Technology policy to address expectations outlined in PPM 128.

C. BACKGROUND

- 1. The policy was last updated on January 29, 2021.
- 2. On April 28, 2024, the Ministry of Education updated PPM 128 and expects school boards to have updated policies in place by September 1, 2024.
- 3. On June 4, 2024, GAP reviewed and approved the revised policy.

D. EVIDENCE/RESEARCH/ANALYSIS

- 1. The proposed updated policy will be formatted into the new policy template.
- 2. Proposed new regulations included to comply with the ministry's direction.

E. GAP RECOMMENDATION

1. GAP recommends to Board that the revised Acceptable Use of Technology Policy provided in Appendix A (tracked) and Appendix B (clean), be approved.
