#### A. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report recommends approval of a total project budget for the addition to St. Victor Catholic School of \$6,254,430.00. This addition will provide three new Full-Day Kindergarten (FDK) rooms, seven classrooms and one Multi-Exceptionality/Developmentally-Delayed (MEDD) classroom and a new FDK playground.

Funding is available and approved by the Ministry of Education (EDU) from Proceeds of Disposition (POD), the Capital grant to accommodate FDK, Capital Land Funding (CLF) and the School Renewal Grant (SRG).

#### **B.** PURPOSE

1. This report is a follow up to the Board direction arising from the report dated September 17, 2015 regarding the Capital Program September 2014-2015, that the Director of Education submit a detailed budget for Board approval for each Capital project prior to tendering.

#### C. BACKGROUND

- 1. On April 11, 2013, the Board approved the Capital Program Phases 3 to 6, including implementation of FDK Years 4 and 5 and expanded additions in conjunction with FDK additions to eliminate portables based on 2018 enrolment projections. An expanded addition consisting of three FDK rooms and seven classrooms at St. Victor Catholic School was approved with a project budget of \$5,074,080.00, to be funded by FDK funding at \$990,000.00 and Proceeds of Disposition (POD) at \$4,084,080.00.
- 2. On April 11, 2013, the Board approved the appointment of NGA Architects as consultants for the FDK + expanded addition to St. Victor Catholic School at a cost of \$297,479.80, including net HST.
- 3. On April 30, 2014 the Ministry of Education (EDU) approved seven TCDSB Capital Priorities projects, including the addition of 161 elementary and 78 FDK pupil places, to St. Victor Catholic School at a benchmark project cost of \$5,360,846.00, utilizing FDK funding of \$998,260 and POD at \$4,362,586.00. The approval letter also invited the Board to submit detailed estimates of site preparation and/or demolition costs for the Capital Priorities projects for consideration for additional Ministry funding.

- 4. On June 5, 2014 the Board approved an updated Capital Program for Phases 3 to 6, reflecting increased availability of POD due to Capital Priorities funding for two projects and providing updated project cost estimates. The project budget for St. Victor Catholic School was increased to \$5,748,484.00, based on preliminary construction cost estimates, utilizing FDK funding of \$998,260.00, POD at \$4,362,586.00 and \$387,638.00 from the School Renewal Grant (SRG).
- 5. On March 31, 2015, EDU approved the Space Plan template for the FDK + expanded addition to St. Victor Catholic School for 248 additional pupil places and a final school capacity of 467 pupil places (the increased capacity over the Capital Priorities approval to accommodate the need for a purpose-built MEDD room). It should be noted that because this is a classroom addition only, with no unloaded or non-instructional spaces such as a gymnasium or administration space, the **proposed Gross Floor Area**, at 1,581 sq.m., is only 62% of the EDU benchmark area for 248 pupil places of 2,559 sq.m. The resulting school with the completed addition, at 3,693 sq.m., will be 77% of the EDU sample school benchmark area of 4,820 sq.m.
- 6. On April 27, 2015, 2015, Associate Directors' Council approved the award of a contract to Pact Engineering Inc. for mechanical commissioning services for the addition at St. Victor Catholic School at a cost of \$8,632.52, including net HST.

#### E. ACTION PLAN

- 1. On March 30, 2015, A.W. Hooker provided a construction cost estimate for the FDK + expanded addition at St. Victor Catholic School, including a breakdown of site preparation and other extraordinary costs, such as City of Toronto Site Plan Approval and Green Standard requirements, based on design development drawings provided by NGA Architects. The site preparation and extraordinary costs resulted in an increased total project cost estimate of \$6,254,430.00.
- 2. On March 31, 2015, a request for additional funding of \$543,062.00 for site preparation and extraordinary costs for the addition to St. Victor Catholic School was submitted to EDU with the detailed cost breakdown, assuming the use of \$350,522.00 in SRG funds for renovations to the existing building and site improvements.
- 3. On July 20, 2015, EDU granted Approval to Proceed to tender (ATP) for the addition to St. Victor Catholic School, for a project cost of \$6,254,430.00, including approval of Capital Land Funding (CLF) of up to \$711,901.00 for unique site costs and utilizing \$181,683.00 in SRG funds, as well as the Capital Priorities approved FDK funding of \$998,260.00 and POD at \$4,362,586.00. Refer to Appendix A.
- 4. The Approval to Proceed letter instructed the Board to structure the tender documents to identify unique site costs separately, with the funding allocation to be adjusted to match the costs identified by the successful bidder, up to a maximum of the funding approval of \$711,901.00. The approved unique site costs included \$48,015.00 for cash-in-lieu of a green roof, which has subsequently been determined not to be required for this size of addition. This has been allocated to the contingency in the budget.

#### F. METRICS AND ACCOUNTABILITY

1. Table 1 below outlines the project budget for the addition to St. Victor Catholic School, based on the EDU Approval to Proceed:

2. A further report will be submitted to Board to approve the award of the construction contract following tendering and the project budget will be updated to reflect the actual tender price.

### G. IMPLEMENTATION, STRATEGIC COMMUNICATIONS AND STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT PLAN

- 1. The Notice of Approval Conditions (NOAC) for the Site Plan Agreement was received from the City of Toronto on August 31, 2015 and work has been completed to satisfy the approval conditions (provision of letters of credit to guarantee landscaping work and sidewalk replacement, road widening conveyance). Finalization of the Site Plan Agreement by the City is underway.
- 2. The building permit application was submitted on September 1, 2015. The permit will not be issued until the Site Plan Agreement is finalized.
- 3. Tendering of the project is scheduled for mid-November 2015, with construction to begin in early spring 2016, as soon as weather permits. Completion of the addition and the minor renovations to the existing school is expected for September 2017.
- 4. A public meeting for parents and nearby residents was held at the school on June 23, 2015 to present the addition design and discuss the impact of construction activities. A letter will be sent to the neighbours to notify them of the start of construction once the tender is approved.

#### H. STAFF RECOMMENDATION

1. That the project budget for the FDK + expanded addition to St. Victor Catholic School of \$6,254,430.00 be approved and funded as follows:
