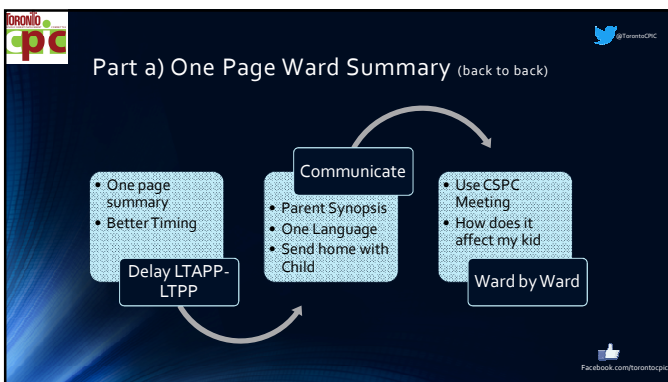



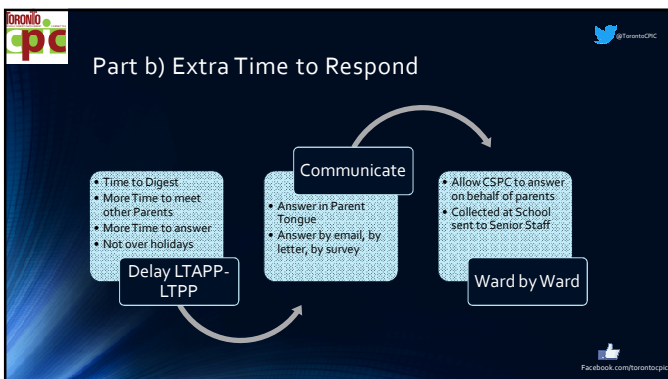
LTAPP & LTPP Parent Consult Motion 16/12-06

- Extra time be allowed for parents to properly respond to the one-page summary on the real effect of these changes.

Use Toronto Catholic PIC & OAPCE Toronto Motion 16/12-07

- When any level of parent consultation is required by the TCDSB that the consultation strategies be discussed with the Toronto Catholic PIC in advance, and that the Toronto Catholic PIC be allowed to recommend to the TCDSB Trustees the parent consultation strategy appropriate to the intended objectives;
- Prior to the start of the consultation process, OAPCE Toronto be consulted on the appropriate method of deploying the selected consultation strategy.



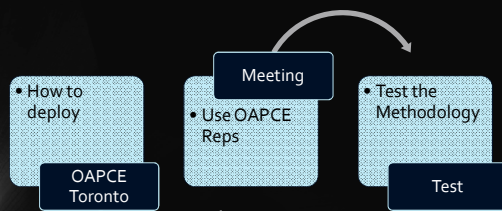


Part a) Best Parent Strategy
