Psychology

Psychology/Learning Disabilities

Members of the Psychology Department, Assessment and Programming Teachers and Mathematics Resource Teachers jointly delivered 4 full-day workshops to intermediate Mathematics and Special Education Teachers on Learning Disabilities, their impact on learning/teaching Math, and strategies for the classroom. The workshops were on December 4 and 11. The feedback received was positive and indicated a need for more similar types of professional development. A similar workshop will be offered to secondary teachers in February.
